- Insert the magazine into the firearm as described in the installation instructions.
- To remove the magazine, press the magazine release button and pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

3. Maintenance:

- Regularly clean the magazine to ensure reliable performance. Use a soft cloth and a suitable cleaning solvent.
- Inspect the feed lips and follower for any signs of wear or damage.
