Drop-In Trigger Module Is Factory Tuned For A Super Smooth, Clean-Breaking Pull

CMC's self-contained, drop-in trigger module replaces the heavy factory trigger found in many commercial AR-15s and delivers a crisp, clean pull with a consistent, pre-set pull weight. Originally designed by competition shooter Chip McCormick to provide all the advantages of a fine, match-grade, single-stage trigger without having to fit and adjust multiple components. A rigid, steel, trigger housing holds all the factory-tuned internal components in proper alignment for easy, fast installation. Generous, precision-ground sear/hammer engagement surfaces provide a remarkably clean, crisp release while preserving reliable function. Each trigger assembly is tweaked at the factory to minimize take-up and over-travel. Threaded sleeves provide ultra-smooth pivot surfaces for the hammer and trigger. Two, slightly oversized center pins replace the standard, trigger/hammer pins to save wear, reduce friction, and prevent trigger wobble; "Chicago"-style screws prevent pin walk. CMC single-stage AR-15 triggers are available with traditional Curved trigger shoe, or skeletonized Flat shoe that provides a different feel some shooters prefer and gives your AR a distinctive look. Two-stage models also available - see separate listing.

Consumer Safety Instruction Guide for CMC Triggers AR15 Tactical Trigger Group

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CMC Triggers AR15 Tactical Trigger Group. This guide provides essential safety instructions and information to ensure the safe use and installation of your new trigger module. Please read this guide carefully before use.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the trigger module is installed by a qualified gunsmith or experienced individual familiar with AR15 systems.
- Always treat firearms as if they are loaded. Keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- Before installation or handling, ensure that the firearm is unloaded and the chamber is clear.
- Be aware of your surroundings and ensure that no unauthorized persons are nearby during installation or usage.
- Regularly inspect your trigger and firearm for any signs of wear or damage. If any issues are found, discontinue use immediately and consult a professional.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Only use the CMC Triggers AR15 Tactical Trigger Group with compatible AR15 or AR308 platforms that utilize .154" diameter trigger and hammer pins.
- Do not attempt to modify or adjust the trigger pull weight, as it is factory set and nonadjustable.
- Ensure that all safety mechanisms of the firearm are functional before use.
- Keep fingers off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- Use appropriate protective gear, including eye and ear protection, when operating the firearm.
- Store the firearm and trigger module in a secure location, away from children and unauthorized users.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation Instructions

1. Preparation

- Gather necessary tools: a punch tool, hammer, and safety glasses.
- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and the chamber is clear.

2. Remove the Old Trigger

- Use the punch tool to remove the existing trigger and hammer pins.
- Carefully take out the old trigger group from the lower receiver.

3. Install the CMC Trigger Module

- Place the CMC Trigger module into the lower receiver.
- Align the threaded sleeves with the pivot holes.
- Insert the oversized center pins into the trigger and hammer pivot holes.
- Ensure the pins are securely in place and do not wobble.

4. Check Functionality

- After installation, check the trigger's functionality by dry firing in a safe environment.

- Ensure that the trigger resets properly and that there is no excessive play.

5. Final Inspection

- Inspect the installation to ensure everything is secure and properly aligned.
- Reinstall any other components that were removed during the process.
