- Hold the punch firmly by the knurled section for better grip.
- Using a hammer, gently strike the end of the punch to drive the pin out or into place. Repeat as necessary until the pin is removed or installed.

3. PostUse Care:

- After use, clean the punch to remove any debris or residue.
- Inspect the punch for any signs of damage and store it in its designated storage area.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or unusable roll pin punches according to local regulations for metal waste.
