# MIL/LE PISTOL CLEANING KIT DEWEY Safety Instructions

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MIL/LE PISTOL CLEANING KIT DEWEY. This kit is designed for the basic cleaning of service pistols in various calibers, specifically for military and law enforcement use. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle firearms with care and ensure they are unloaded before cleaning.
- Keep the cleaning kit and all its components out of reach of children and unauthorized users.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Assemble all components of the cleaning kit on a clean, flat surface.

### 2. Cleaning Process

- Attach the 6" brass cleaning rod to the brass loop.
- Insert the bronze bore brush into the cleaning rod and apply a small amount of Shooter's Choice FP10 cleaner to the brush.
- Insert the brush into the barrel and gently scrub the interior, taking care to protect the rifling.
- Remove the brush and replace it with a cotton flannel patch attached to the brass loop to wipe down the barrel.
- Repeat the process until the patches come out clean.
- Use the doubleended nylon parts brush to clean other components of the firearm as needed.

### 3. PostCleaning

- Wipe down the exterior of the firearm with the siliconeimpregnated wipedown cloth.
- Apply a light coat of Shooter's Choice FP10 for lubrication.
- Store all components back in the zippered storage pouch.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of used cleaning patches and any waste materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning solvents in regular trash or down the drain; follow local hazardous waste disposal guidelines.
- Keep the packaging and any unused components in a safe place until you confirm they are no longer needed.
