Similar in hardness to brass, Copper Eliminator parts won't scratch the bore or damage the muzzle, and they'll stand up to hard use. Top-quality steel rods have the same tough, nylon outer coating and ball-bearing smooth rotating handle as standard Dewey rods, with an 8-32 female threaded aluminum ferrule. Each rod comes with an aluminum Copper Eliminator jag.
