MARK II SAFETY User Manual

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MARK II SAFETY by Dayton Traister. This safety device is designed to enhance the functionality of your Mauser rifles (models M93, M94, M95, and M96) while ensuring safe operation. Please read this manual carefully to understand how to use and maintain your product safely and effectively.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat your firearm as if it is loaded.
- Keep the safety engaged until you are ready to fire.
- Ensure that the rifle is pointed in a safe direction at all times.

- If you experience any difficulty with the installation or operation of the safety, consult a professional gunsmith for assistance.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation Steps

1. **Prepare Your Firearm** Ensure the firearm is unloaded. Remove the bolt from the rifle.
2. **Slotting the Bolt Sleeve** Using a suitable tool, carefully slot the bolt sleeve as required for the installation of the MARK II SAFETY. Take care to avoid damaging other components of the firearm.
3. **Install the MARK II SAFETY** Align the safety device with the designated area on the rifle. Securely attach the safety in place, ensuring it is firmly seated.
4. **Final Check** Reinstall the bolt into the rifle. Test the safety device to ensure it operates smoothly and correctly.

Usage

- To engage the safety, simply move the lever to the "safe" position.
- To disengage, move the lever to the "fire" position.
- Always ensure the safety is engaged when the firearm is not in use.
