Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 740, 760/ITHACA 37 Scope Bases
