Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

- Apply a drop of blue Loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

- Once installed, mount your scope onto the Picatinny rail.
- Adjust the scope's eye relief as needed for optimal viewing.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws and the stability of the scope.
