Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting. Now comes with #6 and #8 screws.

- Adjust the eye relief and position as needed for comfort and accuracy.
- Secure the scope rings according to the manufacturer's instructions.

4. PostInstallation Check:
