The finely checkered, extended button is .040" higher than the original 1911A1 factory button to ensure fast positive magazine release on the first try. Precision machined on a state-of-the-art, four-axis CNC cutting station from high-grade steel barstock to ensure exact dimensions and superb strength. Available with a satin blued finish or hard-chromed for extra corrosion resistance and lubricity.
