Proprietary steel alloy is precision machined with the latest CNC equipment, then vacuum heat-treated to Rc 49-51 for superb strength and tension-retaining properties. All inside corners are radiused to eliminate the sharp 90° corners where failures often occur. Claw is wider than factory specification and undercut and positioned closer to the bolt face for a tighter grip on the case rim. Body is longer, so it can be custom fitted to your slide, and nearly three times as thick as factory original for greater strength.
