Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 700, 722, 40X LONG ACTION HD SCOPE BASES

Introduction

- Avoid overtightening the screws as this may damage the scope bases or the firearm.
- Do not modify the scope bases in any way, as this may compromise safety and functionality.
- Use the scope bases only for their intended purpose - mounting scopes securely to the firearm.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools, including a Torx® wrench.
- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.

2. Installation Steps

- Locate the factory scope mount holes on the receiver of your firearm.
- Align the scope bases with the mount holes.
- Insert the socket head Torx® screws into the holes and handtighten them.
- Using the Torx® wrench, tighten the screws to the recommended torque of 20 inch lbs. Ensure even pressure on all screws to maintain stability.
- Apply a drop of blue loctite to each screw to prevent loosening due to recoil.

3. Usage

- Once installed, mount your scope onto the Picatinny rail, ensuring it is securely attached.
- Adjust the scope as necessary for proper eye relief and alignment before use.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws and the condition of the scope bases during routine firearm maintenance.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Contact local waste management authorities for proper disposal methods.
