Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to  $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

# Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 700, 722, 40X SHORT ACTION HD SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

- **Loctite Application:** Apply a drop of blue Loctite to the screws to prevent loosening.
- **Compatibility Check:** Verify that the scope rings used are compatible with both Picatinny and Weaver systems.
- **Weight Consideration:** Be aware that the Heavy Duty mounts are designed to be .100" lower than Lightweight mounts, which may affect the centerline of your optic.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation:

- Gather all necessary tools: a torque wrench, a Torx wrench, and blue Loctite.
- Ensure the firearm is in a safe and stable position.

### 2. Installation Steps:

- Remove any existing scope mounts from the firearm.
- Align the EGW scope bases with the factory scope mount holes on the receiver.
- Insert the Torx screws into the aligned holes.
- Using the torque wrench, tighten each screw to a torque specification of 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drop of blue Loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

### 3. Usage:

- After installation, mount your scope onto the Picatinny rail.
- Adjust the eye relief as needed for optimal viewing.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws and the stability of the scope during use.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations for metal and aluminum recycling.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Instead, take it to a designated recycling center.
