Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty (HD) mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to $\pm .002$ ". Machined from ultra-rigid 4140 carbon steel pre-hardened to Rc 35-35 before machining. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.
