Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting.

Introduction

- Apply a drop of blue loctite to each screw to ensure they remain secure.

- Attach your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings to the installed scope bases.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for mounting your scope onto the rings.
- Ensure that the scope is securely fastened and properly aligned.

4. Final Checks:

- Inspect the installation to ensure all screws are tight and the scope is securely mounted.
- Perform a function check to ensure the firearm operates safely with the mounted scope.
