Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

# Safety Instruction Guide for BROWNING XBOLT SHORT ACTION HD SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

- Be aware that Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than Lightweight mounts. Ensure this meets your requirements for accuracy and comfort.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Gather all necessary tools, including a socket head Torx® wrench.
- Ensure the firearm is in a safe and stable position.

2. **Installation Steps:**

- Confirm that the factory scope mount holes on the receiver are clean and free of debris.
- Align the scope base with the predrilled holes on the receiver.
- Insert the Torx® screws into the holes and handtighten them.
- Using the Torx® wrench, tighten the screws to the recommended torque of 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drip of blue Loctite to each screw to ensure they remain secure.

### 3. Usage:

- Once installed, mount your scope onto the Picatinny rail.
- Adjust the scope to your desired eye relief and secure it in place with the appropriate rings.
- Regularly check the tightness of all screws and mounts to ensure safety during use.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste.
- Consider recycling the aluminum components if possible.
