Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

# Safety Instruction Guide for KIMBER 8400 LONG ACTION HD SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

- Apply a small drop of blue Loctite to the screws to ensure they remain securely fastened.

### 3. Usage

- Once installed, mount your Picatinny or Weaver scope rings onto the scope bases.
- Adjust the scope to achieve the desired eye relief.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws, especially after initial usage and after any significant changes in temperature or humidity.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local recycling regulations.
- If the scope bases are no longer in use, consider recycling the aluminum material where facilities are

available.

- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Follow local regulations for hazardous materials if applicable.
