Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on the gun's receiver. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Lightweight Tactical mounts have a milled center channel for weight reduction. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to ± 0.002 ". Machined from ultra-rigid, extruded 6061 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite for mounting. Note: Also fits Benelli Auto/Super Black Eagle/Vinci/M2, Weaver 93, Stoeger M3000/M3500 (after serial #1368845)

- Regularly check the tightness of the screws and the condition of the scope bases during use.
