Precision machined from extruded aluminum with Picatinny slot-and-rail spacing that allows fast and simple changes to eye relief, plus great flexibility in scope choice. Drilled to fit the factory scope mount holes on those Winchester Model 70 long action rifles that use an .860 hole spacing on the front and rear receiver rings. Accepts Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Heavy Duty mounts are .100" lower than the Lightweight mounts to minimize weight and keep your optic closer to the barrel centerline for improved accuracy. Full-width cross-slots are gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs to +/- .002". Machined from ultra-rigid extruded 7075 T6 aluminum. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite.

- Ensure that the scope is properly aligned and securely mounted to prevent it from shifting during use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools, including a socket head Torx® wrench.
- Ensure your workspace is clean and welllit.

2. Installation Steps

- **Step 1:** Ensure the firearm is unloaded. Remove any existing scope mounts if applicable.
- **Step 2:** Align the EGW Winchester 70 HD Scope Bases with the factory scope mount holes on your rifle.
- **Step 3:** Insert the provided socket head Torx® screws into the holes and handtighten them.
- **Step 4:** Use the Torx® wrench to tighten the screws to the recommended torque of 20 inch lbs.
- **Step 5:** Apply a drop of blue Loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

3. Usage Guidelines

- After installation, check the alignment and stability of the scope.
- Make any necessary adjustments to the eye relief and scope position before taking your firearm to the range.
- Regularly inspect the scope bases and screws for tightness and wear, especially before and after use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
