Built-in 20 MOA of elevation. Drilled to fit factory scope mount holes on receiver. Includes socket head Torx® screws and wrench. EGW recommends 20 inch-lbs of torque and a dab of blue Loctite to anchor your Winchester Pre-'64 Model 70 long action Picatinny scope base securely.

- Apply a small dab of blue Loctite to the screws if desired for added security.
- Check that the scope base is firmly attached and that there is no movement.

### **3. Usage:**

- Attach your scope to the Picatinny rail according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Adjust the scope for eye relief and ensure it is securely mounted.
- Regularly check the scope and base for any looseness or wear during use.
