These bases sit at approximately 0.35" high. Picatinny cross slots run the full  
length of the rail, which gives the shooter flexibility when mounting scope  
rings and other accessories. The cross slots are also machined the full width of  
the mount and gauged to MIL-STD 1913 specs maintaining tolerances of +/-  
.002". After machining; the mounts are tumbled and sand blasted. The  
aluminum mounts are Type III hard coat anodized for long lasting durability.  
The steel rails are Mil Spec parkerized for a durable rust resistant finish.  
Compatible with Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. Add EGW's HD Scope Rings  
to make it a complete package! From manufacturing to packaging, EGW's  
products are made with pride in the USA. Installation: EGW recommends 20  
inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite (loctite is available through our  
website and is sold separately).

# Safety Instruction Guide for MONTANA RIFLE 1999 LONG ACTION HD SCOPE BASES

## Introduction

- Use a drop of blue Loctite to secure screws, ensuring they do not loosen during use.
- Be aware that the base sits approximately 0.35 inches high; ensure your scope is compatible with this height.
- The cross slots are machined to MILSTD 1913 specifications; ensure that all accessories used are compliant to maintain safety.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation:

- Gather all necessary tools including the provided T10 bit and a torque wrench.
- Ensure the installation area is clean and free from distractions.

### 2. Installation Steps:

- Position the scope base on the receiver of your rifle, aligning the holes with the mounting points.
- Insert the #648 X 1/4 screws into the holes of the scope base.
- Using the T10 bit, tighten the screws gradually, ensuring even pressure across the base.
- Apply torque to each screw, ensuring not to exceed 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drop of blue Loctite to each screw to secure them in place.

### 3. PostInstallation:

- Inspect the installation to ensure all screws are tight and the base is securely mounted.
- Check for any movement or misalignment before attaching your scope.
