

# TIKKA T3X TAC A1 HD PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT - EGW TIKKA T3X TAC A1 1-PIECE PICATINNY BASE 30 MOA

There is a screw in the front of the original mount that is located underneath the handguard. The handguard must be removed and then this screw must also be removed before the original mount can be removed. Removing the original mount may be a difficult task. Please use caution when removing the original mount and when installing EGW mount. EGW always recommends having their products installed by a competent and qualified gunsmith. Metric screws are only available with hex heads. EGW recommends measuring the hole spacing in your receiver to confirm it matches with the dimensions they have published. Picatinny cross slots run the full length of the rail, which gives the shooter flexibility when mounting scope rings and other accessories. EGW one-piece scope mounts are the obvious choice for hunters and tactical shooters alike. This mount is a Picatinny-style base and compatible with Picatinny or Weaver scope rings. EGW machines these in their shop using one of their machining centers. After machining, the mounts are tumbled, sand blasted, and Type III anodized for long lasting durability. Recommend: 20 MOA - if shooting 500-1000 yards When zeroing your rifle with a 20 MOA mount, EGW recommends zeroing at 200 yards. Installation: EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite (loctite is sold separately). The entire mount and accessories (from the mounting screws and wrench down to the packaging) are made in the USA.

# Safety Instruction Guide for TIKKA T3X TAC A1 HD PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT

## Introduction

- Use only the recommended torque of 20 inch lbs when securing the mount.
- Apply a drop of blue Loctite to the screws to prevent loosening during use. Note that Loctite is sold separately.
- Ensure that the hole spacing in your receiver matches the dimensions provided by EGW before installation.
- Be aware that metric screws are only available with hex heads.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Remove the handguard to access the front screw of the original mount.
- Carefully remove the front screw before attempting to remove the original mount.

### 2. Removing the Original Mount

- Use caution when removing the original mount, as it may require additional force.
- If you encounter resistance, do not force the mount. Consult a qualified gunsmith if necessary.

### 3. Installing the EGW Mount

- Align the EGW Picatinny scope mount with the holes in your receiver.
- Secure the mount using the provided screws, ensuring they are tightened to 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drop of blue Loctite to each screw before tightening.

### 4. Zeroing Your Rifle

- For optimal performance, zero your rifle at 200 yards when using a 20 MOA mount.
- Confirm that the scope rings and other accessories are securely mounted on the Picatinny rail.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the scope mount and any packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste. Check for local recycling programs.
