- The bushing has a .702" O.D. and .574" (14.6mm) I.D.
- Fitting of both dimensions is necessary. Consult a qualified gunsmith for installation.
- Ensure the bushing is correctly aligned and secured during installation.

3. PostInstallation Checks:

- After installation, perform a function check of the firearm to ensure proper operation.
- Inspect the bushing for any signs of movement or improper fit.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or unusable bushings in accordance with local regulations.
