Center channel reduces weight and allows for the use of the factory iron sights. Clamps to the barrel for maximum stability and accuracy with 8 clamping screws vs. the factory 6 screws. Provides 7 inches of MIL-STD 1913 "Picatinny" rail. Extends rearward to the front of the receiver for mounting "Scout" style scopes.

Introduction
