REMINGTON 788 3RD MAGAZINE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the REMINGTON 788 3rd Magazine for your 308 Winchester firearm. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your magazine.
