SCREW HEAD POLISHING VISE SAFETY INSTRUCTION GUIDE

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SCREW HEAD POLISHING VISE from BROWNELLS. This product is designed to provide a superior way to hold screws and pins securely while polishing heads, helping to prevent burned fingers and loss of screws during the polishing process. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the SCREW HEAD POLISHING VISE is used only for its intended purpose.
