On tapered barrels, the milled "V" can be shimmed to ensure true tap entry. Handles all tap sizes from 3/8" to 0-80, except No. 12 and No. 14. Wood block holds bushing assortment and has holes for regularly used taps.

Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Setup:

- Place the TAP GUIDE on a stable and flat surface.
- Confirm that the wood block is securely holding the bushing assortment.
- Ensure that the holes for regularly used taps are clear and accessible.

2. Using the TAP GUIDE:

- Select the appropriate tap size and insert it into the TAP GUIDE.
- Align the TAP GUIDE over the workpiece, ensuring it is square to the hole.
- If working with tapered barrels, adjust the milled "V" as needed using shims.
- Begin tapping by applying consistent, gentle pressure while rotating the tap.
- Monitor the alignment regularly to ensure the tap remains square in the hole.

3. PostUse:

- After completing the tapping process, carefully remove the TAP GUIDE.
- Clean the TAP GUIDE and store it in a safe place to prevent damage.

- Dispose of the TAPRITE TAP GUIDE in accordance with local regulations regarding metal and plastic waste.
