# Safety Instructions for the BARREL BEDDING TOOL GUNLINE 5/8" BARREL BEDDING TOOL

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the BARREL BEDDING TOOL GUNLINE 5/8" BARREL BEDDING TOOL. This tool is designed to provide a perfect, chatterfree cut for bedding your barrel.
