REMINGTON BOLT DISASSEMBLY TOOL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Remington Bolt Disassembly Tool manufactured by Kleinendorst. This tool is designed to facilitate the safe and efficient disassembly of Remington bolts. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe usage and compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).
