Introduction

- Once installed, doublecheck that the scope mount is securely attached and does not wobble.

3. Usage

- Attach your scope using Weaverstyle rings that are compatible with the scope mount.
- Adjust the scope to ensure proper eye relief and alignment before firing.
- Test the setup at a safe shooting range to ensure stability and accuracy.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials responsibly, following local waste management regulations.
- If the scope mount is no longer needed or is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling the aluminum material if possible.
- Dispose of any nonrecyclable components in accordance with local guidelines for hazardous waste.
