 - 5 ½" rod brass cleaning rods & 2" extension

2. Preparing for Cleaning:

- Ensure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Select the appropriate brush, jag, or mop based on the caliber of your firearm.

3. Using the Cleaning Rod:

- Attach the selected brush, jag, or mop to the cleaning rod.

- Insert the cleaning rod into the barrel and gently push it through. Rotate the rod as needed to follow the rifling.
- Repeat as necessary, using patches and gun oil as needed for thorough cleaning.

4. Cleaning the Components:

- After cleaning, use a clean patch to remove any excess oil from the barrel.
- Wipe down all components of the firearm with a dry cloth to remove any residue.

5. Storing the Kit:

- After use, clean all brushes and components with a cloth and store them in the carrying case.
- Ensure the carrying case is closed securely and stored out of reach of children.
