Each ring is 1 1/8" long for maximum contact with scope body, and caps have four hex head clamping screws for recoil-proof holding power. Two, steel, thumb screws and full-length clamping bar securely lock mount to Picatinny receiver rail. Rounded contours and radiused edges resist snagging on other gear. Machined aluminum keeps weight to a minimum.
