USGI CLEANING KIT Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the MILSPEC Cleaning Kit designed for the AR15/M16. This kit includes essential components for maintaining your firearm, ensuring optimal performance and safety. 2. Cleaning Process:

- **Assemble the Cleaning Rod:**
 - Connect the sectional cleaning rod pieces together using the combo handle.
- **Bore Cleaning:**
 - Attach the bore brush to the cleaning rod.
 - Insert the brush into the firearm's chamber and push through the barrel.
 - Repeat this process several times to remove fouling.
- **Chamber Cleaning:**
 - Use the chamber brush, ensuring it fits snugly in the chamber.
 - Rotate gently while inserting and removing the brush.
- **Part Cleaning:**
 - Use the doubleended parts brush to clean small parts of the firearm.

- The nylon bristles are suitable for delicate surfaces.
- **Oiling:**
 - Fill the oiler bottle with appropriate firearm oil.
 - Apply a small amount of oil to the moving parts of the firearm to ensure proper lubrication.
- **Patch Cleaning:**
 - Attach a patch to the patch loop and moisten it with cleaning solvent.
 - Run the patch through the barrel to remove remaining debris.

3. **PostCleaning:**

- Inspect the firearm to ensure it is clean and properly lubricated.
- Store the cleaning kit in its designated compartment in the A2 buttstock or a safe location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any used patches, brushes, or solvents in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of cleaning components in household waste. Check for local hazardous waste disposal guidelines.
