Repeat the application of solution and boiling until color wanted is achieved, then neutralize. Complete instructions included.

No damp cabinets or long rusting periods required to get top-quality, good-looking blues and browns. Heat gun or part to 150°-200° F. with propane torch; swab on solution, and card with soft wire wheel or fine steel wool. Blue #1 does require parts be immersed in boiling water for 5 minutes before carding.
