Safety Instruction Guide for 1911 45ACP MAGAZINES METALFORM

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the METALFORM .45 GOVT/COMM S/S 7 RD magazines for your 1911 Auto pistol. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use of this product. Please read the entire document carefully before using the magazines.
