Safety Instruction Guide for BERETTA SEMI AUTO MAGAZINES MECGAR BERETTA 92 9MM BLUE 15 RND

Introduction

- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Push the magazine firmly into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Press the magazine release button to disengage the magazine.
- Pull the magazine straight out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning the Magazine:
