Introduction

- Insert the sear spring and mainspring (hammer spring) into their designated locations.
- Install the fully machined disconnector, ensuring it fits securely.
- Reassemble the slide and frame, following the manufacturer's guidelines.

3. Testing the Trigger Job

- After installation, conduct a function check to ensure that the trigger operates smoothly and safely.
- Test the trigger pull weight to confirm it meets the specified 3 1/2 lb. (Pro Match) or 4 lb.

- (Commander Match) requirements.
- If any issues arise, disassemble and inspect the components for proper installation.

4. Usage

- Regularly check the trigger job components for wear and tear.
- Clean and maintain your firearm according to the manufacturer's recommendations to ensure optimal performance.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials and unused components in accordance with local regulations.
