Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SIG P228/P299 12RD 40S&W MAGAZINE SIG P229 .40 CAL, 12 RDS. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use, handling, and disposal of your magazine. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

- After firing, remove the magazine by pressing the magazine release button and pulling the magazine out of the firearm.
