H&K VP9 Steel Magazine Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the H&K VP9.
- Firmly push the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Pull the magazine straight out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Regularly clean the magazine using a soft cloth and a suitable cleaning solution.
- Inspect the magazine spring and follower for any signs of wear.
- Store the magazine in a cool, dry place when not in use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer functional, do not attempt to repair it.
