# Ruger LC9® Steel Magazines 9mm Safety Instruction Guide

## Introduction

- Grasp the magazine and pull it straight out of the magazine well.

### 4. Unloading the Magazine:

- Carefully push the follower down and remove each round, ensuring the firearm remains pointed in a safe direction.
