These two all-steel magazines provide that to owners of the company's CPX-1 and CPX-2 handguns. The SCCY CPX-1/CPX-2 steel magazine is designed for use with 9mm cartridges only and have a magazine body made from heat-treated carbon steel. The magazine is treated with a black-oxide finish that combats corrosion and premature wear. Inside each SCCY CPX-1/CPX-2 steel magazine, you'll find a spring formed from heat-treated chrome-silicon wire, as well as an injection-molded follower. The magazines are available with a 15-round and a 32-round capacity and are made in the USA.

SCCY CPX1/CPX2 Steel Magazines Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SCCY CPX1/CPX2 Steel Magazines. These magazines are designed for use with your SCCY CPX1 and CPX2 handguns, providing reliable performance for your 9mm cartridges. This safety instruction guide is intended to help you understand how to use and care for your magazines safely and effectively in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that you are familiar with the operating manual of your SCCY handgun before using the magazines.
- Always treat firearms and ammunition with respect and caution.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Loading the Magazine

- Hold the magazine with the base facing down and the feed lips facing up.
- Insert the first cartridge into the magazine by placing it at the rear of the magazine and pushing it down until it clicks into place.
- Continue loading cartridges one at a time until you reach the magazine's capacity of 15 rounds.
- Ensure that each cartridge is securely seated in the magazine.

2. Installing the Magazine in the Handgun

- With the handgun pointed in a safe direction, ensure that the chamber is clear and the firearm is unloaded.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the handgun.
- Push the magazine firmly into the magazine well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine

- To remove the magazine, press the magazine release button located on the handgun.
- Grasp the magazine and pull it straight out of the magazine well.

4. Handling and Maintenance

- After use, clean the magazine with a soft cloth to remove dirt and debris.
- Inspect the magazine for any signs of wear or damage.
- Store the magazine in a cool, dry place when not in use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn magazines in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is no longer usable, consider recycling the steel material if possible.
- Do not dispose of magazines in regular household waste.
