The magazine is treated with a black-oxide finish that combats corrosion and premature wear. Inside each SCCY CPX-1/CPX-2 steel magazine, you'll find a spring formed from heat-treated chrome-silicon wire, as well as an injection-molded follower. The magazines are available with a 15-round and a 32-round capacity and are made in the USA.

- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Firmly push the magazine until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine from the Firearm

- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Regularly clean the magazine to prevent dirt and debris buildup.
