SIG SAUER P320 STEEL MAGAZINE 9MM Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SIG SAUER P320 Steel Magazine 9mm. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your magazine. Please read this manual carefully before using the product.

- Insert the first round into the magazine, pushing it down until it clicks into place.
- Continue to load rounds one at a time until the magazine is full, ensuring each round is seated properly.
- Do not exceed the 17round capacity.

2. Inserting the Magazine into the Firearm

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- With the magazine loaded, align it with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Push the magazine firmly into the magazine well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine from the Firearm

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button to disengage the magazine.
- Pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Unloading the Magazine

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Carefully push the rounds out of the magazine, starting from the bottom.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer functional, do not attempt to repair it. Instead, dispose of it safely to prevent accidental use.
