Bags with a C suffix have a smooth sliding, Cordura bag with a suede base and tie-down tabs to stay in position on the rest. Brass eyelets won't corrode or abrade the tie-down. Superb! NOTE: Bags shipped empty. Fill with sand or lead shot that you provide. No. 16 Brick Bag is a brick-sized bag that makes a perfect rest for arm or elbow.
