Safety Instruction Guide for P250/320 Compact 9mm Luger Handgun Magazines

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the P250/320 Compact 9mm Luger Handgun Magazines. This guide provides important safety instructions to ensure the proper use and handling of your magazine. Please read this manual carefully before use to ensure your safety and the safety of others.

- Stay informed about recall updates through the EU's Safety Gate platform.

- Do not attempt to modify or alter the magazine in any way.
- Only use ammunition that is compatible with the 9mm Luger cartridge.
- Avoid exposing the magazine to extreme temperatures or moisture.
- If the magazine does not function properly, cease use immediately and consult a qualified gunsmith.

Instructions for Installation and Usage
