

This is the correct-weight factory replacement recoil spring for SIG P220 pistols in .45 ACP and P226 pistols in .40 S&W / .357 SIG. If you've kept your P220 or P226 box stock without tweaks or upgrades, this is the correct replacement recoil spring because it provides the factory-spec 20 lbs. of spring force to ensure reliable cycling of the slide. Fits P220 in .45 ACP & P226 in .40 S&W / .357 SIG SIG factory-type braided spring steel construction 20 lb. FACTORY WEIGHT Green paint on one end for ease of identification Sold in a pack of 3 This is a 3-pack of identical 20 lb. replacement recoil springs, NOT a "tuner" pack of different-weight springs. If you're a SIG P220 or P226 owner, buying a pack of these springs pretty much sets you up for life with replacements. Recoil springs lose their force over time, which can lead to cycling problems and failure of the gun to cycle fully into battery. Before you try more expensive solutions, a replacement recoil spring might be the cheap and easy fix.
