Shotgun Bore Mops Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DEWEY Shotgun Bore Mops. These mops are designed to help maintain and clean your shotgun effectively. To ensure your safety and the safe use of this product, please read and follow the safety instructions outlined in this guide.

General Safety Guidelines

- Remove the bore mop from the shotgun rod after use.
- Clean the bore mop with water and allow it to dry before storing.
- Store the bore mop in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn bore mops in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of bore mops in regular household waste if they contain hazardous materials.
