These brass guides protect the crowns of firearms that have to be cleaned from the muzzle. Place the guide on your cleaning rod, start your patch or brush into the barrel, and then slide the guide down into the muzzle. The guide has an O-ring to keep the brass guide cap off of the crown. There is plenty of clearance on the inside diameter of the guide to use any type of cleaning rod (Dewey, Parker Hale, Pro-Shot, etc.). Great for lever actions.
