Each block is machined to fit the specific cases you reload and has finger grooves machined into the sides to provide a sure grip. Each hole has a slight chamfer for easy case head entry. The "Poly" blocks are dishwasher safe for easy cleaning. We use white polyethylene because spilled powder shows up easily. These 50 round blocks are 3/4" thick to provide deeper holes for your cases to sit in, great for short to medium length cartridges. The #749-001-313 block only has 32 holes due to the case head size.
