Each drop tube is fitted with an aluminum sleeve to insure a perfect fit in your powder measure or drop tube adapter. Our .22 caliber and up drop tubes are available in 3/16" inside diameter and 4 different lengths. The longer lengths are great when you are trying to get more powder in a high fill case, especially when using longer bullets. Type A Drop Tubes will require an Adapter for use with Redding Powder measures (749-010-851) or RCBS and Hornady Powder Measures (749-002-916). Type A Drop tubes fill fit directly into Niel Jones Powder Measures.
